Structural Defects Report

This type of Report is usually requested by a valuer or surveyor following their inspection of the property and relates to one or two specific defects for which he requests the opinion of a Chartered Structural / Civil Engineer.



Once instructed, we will make arrangements to visit the property, inspect the specified defects, and produce a formal Report giving an opinion as to cause and structural significance, together with recommendations for further investigations if required, or where appropriate suggest in outline only the scope of any necessary remedial works.

A similar service to that described above can be carried out for a vendor of a property where concerns have been raised by a potential purchaser.



The inspection and the preparation of the Report will be undertaken by an experienced Chartered Engineer and the opinions expressed will be based upon his/her expertise.

For your security all Reports by GCA are backed by £5m professional indemnity insurance cover.

Full Structural Inspection Report

This type of Report is usually recommended by valuers, surveyors or legal representatives where the overall structural condition of a property causes concern, and a second opinion is deemed desirable to give an independent overall assessment of the condition of the structure prior to purchase.

We will make arrangements to visit the property, inspect both externally and internally all easily accessible areas where the view is not obscured, including cellars and roof spaces. We will subsequently produce a formal Report, giving an opinion as to the cause and structural significance of any apparent defect, together with recommendations for further investigations if required, or where appropriate suggest in outline only the scope of any necessary remedial works, including general advice about the likely affects and need to treat any nearby trees and shrubs.

Unless specifically mentioned the survey will exclude an inspection of the electrical and mechanical installations, and all other non-structural matters; it is not normal practice to lift floor coverings or floorboards, remove panels or plaster, or move heavy or bulky items of furniture.

The inspection and the preparation of the Report will be undertaken by an experienced Chartered Engineer and the opinions expressed will be based upon his/her expertise.
